- 1. Application to charities regulator emailed on 01/04/2016. Queries received from them re Trustees in Sept and revised application completed and returned on 22/11/2016.
- 2. 2nd April was Kerry County Clean up day. Few volunteers showed up, yet we collected about 40 bags of rubbish thanks to those who turned out on the day.
- 3. 4th April Niall Fitzgerald presented his ideas in relation to workings within the organisation and how this might bring in new members for certain events.
- 4. 6th April we met with Ian Mc Gregor to formulate a Biodiversity Plan for Tarbert. We had 3 further meeting with him.
- 5. 13th April submitted application for funding for work on the Memorial Plaza using Kerry Community Support Fund 2016.
- 6. 20th April. Attended the Kerry Tourism Network Seminar in Killarney. Met Joan Mc Carthy, Tourism Officer KCC, there and spoke to her about the inaction in the Picnic area.
- 7. 25th April. Three members met Johnny Sheehan at the Picnic area. He promised that work would begin on 3rd May. We gave Johnny a list of our immediate priorities which were 1 Picnis Area 2. Manhole repair at Memorial Plaza. 3. Would like to replace crazy paving at the Memorial plaza. 4. Straighten the leaning light pole on the L1010. 5. Would the council supply gravel for the Island road beds where the shrubs had been removed?
- 8. 26th April. Area at back of fire station cleaned up and a raised bed planted there
- 9. 28th April. Work begins at the Picnic area.
