The sycamore is one of the most common trees of this woodland.**

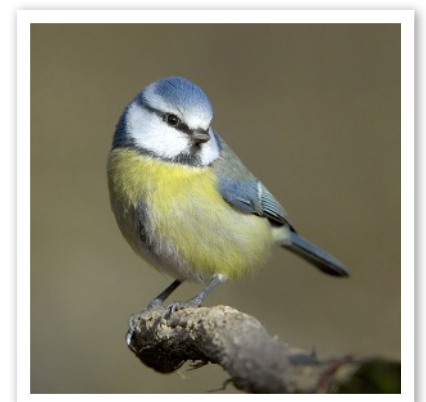
Sycamore

Sycamore is a tree belonging to the Maple family and can grow between 15m -35m tall. On young trees, the bark is smooth and grey but becomes rougher with age and breaks up. The leaves are often marked with black spots or patches. Nowadays it is often seen as a 'weed' which needs to be removed.



Blue tit

Unlike many bird species, the male and female blue tit are almost identical, for the keen eyed birdwatcher...the male is slightly brighter. Blue Tits nest in holes in trees and walls and are commonly found in woodland, hedgerows, parks and gardens. Blue Tits have only one family each year and invest all of their time and energy into raising that one brood. They're widespread and found across the whole of Ireland.
